Debris and trash from parking area floating everywhere, Trash receptacle and Richardson Bay info sign partially submerged. Tidal marker sculptures by artist Jeff Downing were temporarily placed in the water next to the path to raise awareness on sea level rise.

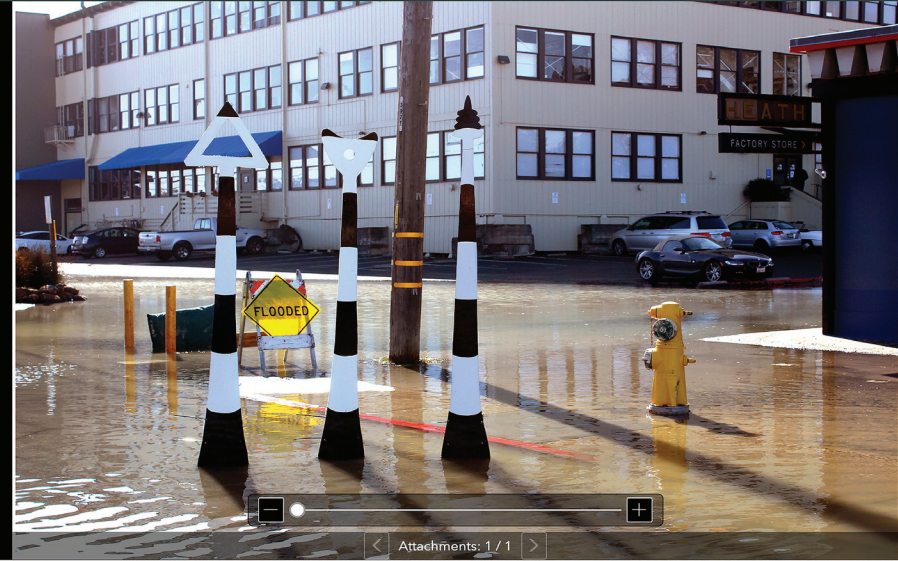

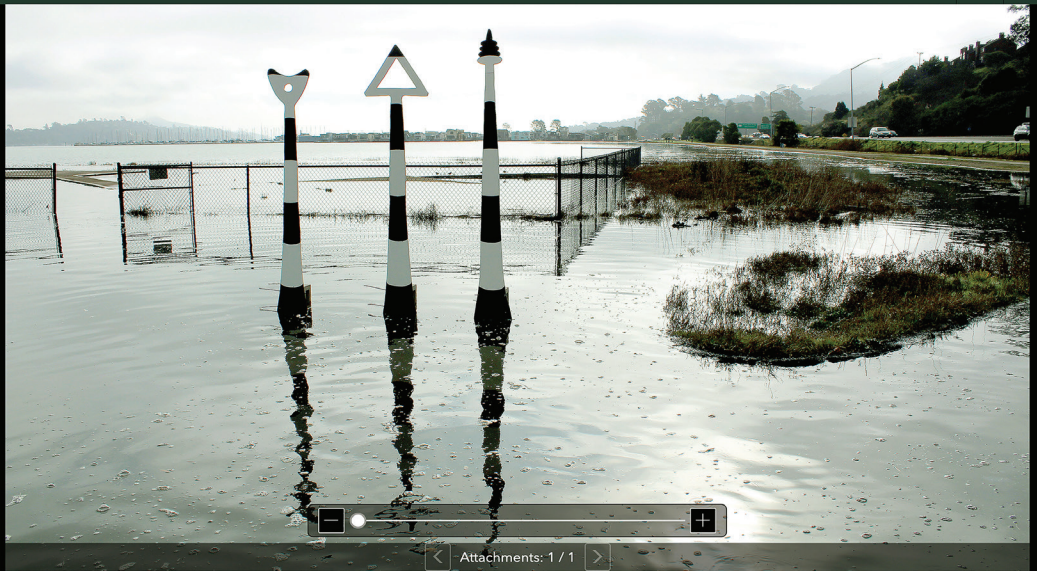

Description
Parking lot, seaplane base and helipad flooded over with 12 -15 inches of seawater 29 minutes before peak high tide. Overcast skies, light winds, no rain. Debris from flooded parking area is floating in with the King Tides. Tidal marker sculptures by artist Jeff Downing were placed in the encroaching waters to raise awareness on the threat of sea level rise.
